

God's Love Is Unconditional

MEMORY VERSE:

I John 4:7, "Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God." (KJV)

TAKE HOME POINT:

God is love.

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TO THE TEACHER:

There are three points to this lesson:

- God is love. Our behavior does not change God's love.
- God's love is unconditional, it cannot be earned.
- 3. There is no end to God's love.There is plenty to go around.

God is love. The Bible says, "nothing can separate us from the love of God." Even if I sin or do bad things, God continues to love me. When I make mistakes He continues to believe the best of me. My behavior does not change the love of God. Nothing can change God's love, because God is love.

God's love is unconditional. The blessings of God are conditional. If I choose to obey God the Bible says I will be blessed. If I choose to disobey God, bad things will happen, but God does not cause bad things to happen. My actions caused the bad things to happen. The blessings of God are conditional, but God's love is unconditional. There is nothing I can do to earn God's love. Just like a parent loves a little baby, God loves us simply because we are His kids. A baby doesn't do anything to earn the love of his parents. We can't do anything to earn God's love.

There is no end to God's love. The Bible says "His mercy endures forever." God is omnipresent. He is not limited by space and time like our parents. There is no end to God, so there is no end to His love. His supply of love will never run out. If we see God do something good for somebody else we don't have to get jealous. There is plenty of His love to go around.

Goal: get the kids to laugh and introduce the lesson.



God is love that He has cooties!

NTB: Alright Mr. Smarty pants! What characteristics does love have?

Teacher: Love is patient. Love is kind. Love is not proud or rude. It does not seek its own

will... (cut off by NTB)

NTB: And it has cooties!

Teacher: No it doesn't! Love is only good things!

NTB: And cooties! And since God is everywhere... (Growing panicked) The cooties

must be everywhere too! This is a national emergency!

Teacher: Not Too Bright! God is love, and he has only good things for us! He is not going

Girl: (Runs after him) But God loves you!

Teacher: (Laughs) Goodbye, Not Too Bright!

OBJECT LESSON Good & Plenty

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE: James 1:17, Psalm 106:1

TAKE HOME POINT: God's love is good and there is plenty to go around.

WHAT YOU NEED: 1 large box of Good and Plenty

SPECIAL NOTES:

Our prayer is that every time they see Good and Plenty they think about how good God's love is.

In each lesson of

an object lesson
that involves
candy. The

you can buy a

specific candy for
the kids to take

OBJECT LESSON APPLICATION:

(Hold up the large box of Good and Plenty - the bigger the better.)

When I was a kid one of my favorite candies was Good and Plenty. (Open the box of candy and begin to eat some.)

Mmmmm. This candy is go good, because it has licorice on the inside. (Continue to talk about how good the candy is, but do not give any to the kids - yet.)

Don't you guys think this is good candy? Everytime I see Good and Plenty candy it reminds me of God's love. God's love is good and there is plenty to go around. The Bible says this "Oh, give thanks unto the Lord, for He is good: for His mercy endureth forever." Do you know what mercy means? It means that God's love and forgiveness has no end. There is nothing we can do to make God stop loving us. There is no sin that we can do that God can't forgive, because God is love and His love endures forever.

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Good & Plenty Object Lesson — Continued

(Start to hand out candy as you preach.)

Do you remember what Jesus said about the men that nailed Him to the cross? How would you like to have been one of the guys that crucified the son of God, the kindest person that ever lived on the planet. That would be a horrible sin. What did Jesus say about them? "Father, forgive them for they don't know what they are doing." Is that how you would pray for someone who was killing you? I don't think so. Most of us would try to call down fire from heaven to consume our enemy. How was Jesus able to forgive the people that murdered Him? There is no end to the love of God.

(At this point you want your box to be empty, but make sure some kids did not get any candy.)

Oh, my! I am out of Good and Plenty! It is all gone. That is a bummer. Some of you did not get any candy. The really good news is that God's love never runs out like this box of candy did. There is no end to His love. There is always plenty to go around.



INTER-ACTIVE OBJECT LESSON

Make Me Laugh

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN: God's love is unconditional.

WHAT YOU NEED: 3 comedians - people that are funny, adults or kids. Let them know ahead of time what they will be doing.

PREPARATION:

- Select 2 boys and 2 girls to be contestants in the "Make Me Laugh" game.
- Have the four contestants wait in the hallway and bring them in one at a time.
- The comedians get 60 seconds to try and make the contestant laugh.
- They can do anything they want, but they cannot touch the contestants.
- The winner is the first kid who does not laugh and makes it through all three comedians.

SPIRITUAL APPLICATION:

You will want to talk about how hard it was to get the winner to laugh. It seemed like no matter what any of the comedians did, they couldn't get him to laugh. This reminds me of God's love. No matter what we do good or bad, God's love for us never changes because He is love. No matter what we did to the winner, we couldn't make him laugh. No matter what we do to God we can't make Him stop loving us.
