

## **Love Your Parents**

**MEMORY VERSE: Ephesians 6:2,** "Honor your father and mother, which is the first

commandment with promise." (NKJV)

**TAKE HOME POINT:** When we obey and honor our Mom and Dad we show them

that we love them.

### TO THE TEACHER:

When we love our parents we obey and honor them.

- Obedience is doing what our parents ask us to do.
- 2. Honoring our parents is doing what our parents ask us to do with a good attitude.

**Love your mom and dad.** For kids the relationship they have with their parents is the most important human relationship they have. We love our parents by obeying them and honoring them.

The Bible says, "Children obey your parents in the Lord for this is right." Jesus said, "If you love me keep my commandments." The same principle is true with our parents. If we love our parents we will obey them. Sometimes our parents may ask us to do hard things, but we still need to obey them. You may not feel like cleaning your room, but you do it anyway because you love your parents.

**Honor your father and mother.** Honor is a step higher than obedience. Honor involves obeying your parents and having a good attitude while you do. When you clean your room before they ask you to do it, that is honoring your mom and dad.

There are many ways to honor your parents:

- 1. Obey them with a good attitude.
- 2. Do things without being told.
- 3. Buy gifts for your parents.
- 4. Say nice things about your parents.
- 5. Never say disrespectful words to your parents.

**Goal:** get the kids to laugh and introduce the lesson.



### **DRAMA SCRIPT:**

LPL: Good morning boys and girls! I have a revolutionary product for you!

Teacher: If you are selling it, I'm sure that we can do without it.

LPL: It will only take a minute to demonstrate, and once they see it, every boy and

girl in the room will buy one!

Teacher: What is it?

LPL: The Robo-Mommy 3000!

Teacher: The Robo-what?

LPL: The Robo-Mommy 3000! Allow me to demonstrate.

(Mom and Daniel enter)

LPL: Observe a typical situation with the normal Mommy.

Mom: Daniel, you need to clean your room before you go to Christopher's house.

Daniel: Mom, I don't want to clean my room!

Mom: Then you can't go to Christopher's house. I'm sorry.

LPL: Everyone has situations like these. Mom won't let you eat ten cookies. Mom

makes you take a bath more than once a month! She is just cramping your

style!

Daniel: Yeah!

LPL: Well, not anymore! With the Robo-Mommy 3000 you can do what you want

when you want. Observe.

(Robo-Mommy 3000 enters.)

Robo: Hi. I'm the new mommy. We won't be needing you anymore. (Picks up Mom

and throws her off stage left)

Daniel: Whoa! Cool.

Robo: Now clean your room, Daniel!

LPL: (Hands Danny the Video Game Control) Try this.

Robo: Danny! I said to clean your room!

Daniel: (Uses control) No!

Robo: (Smiles) O.K. have fun.

Daniel: Whoa! (Uses control) Hey mom! Get me some cookies!

Daniel: (Uses remote control) Actually, it is a good idea.

Robo: You're right Daniel. Eat up!

Daniel: Yes! (Stuffs cookies in his mouth)

Teacher: Daniel... Daniel... I don't think that it's a good idea to eat all of those cookies.

Daniel: (Stuffing his face) Delicious!

Robo: Look at my boy go!

LPL: Look at all of the amazing benefits of the Robo-Mommy 3000! Now who wants

one?

Daniel: (Clutching stomach) Uhh... I don't feel good.

Robo: Well that's just too bad.

Daniel: (Uses remote) Make me feel better.

Daniel: How do you love your parents?

Teacher: One way of showing that you love your parents is by doing the things they ask

you to do with a joyful heart, and by not treating them disrespectfully.

Daniel: So if I want to show my mom that I love her, I obey her.

Teacher: That's right.

Daniel: And not saying rude things to her.

Teacher: Exactly.

Daniel: Sorry, Low Priced Lou. I don't want the Robo-Mommy 3000 anymore. I love my

real parents too much to have a fake one.

LPL: Oh... (Perks up) Well, she makes a great garden assistant... In fact she is also

known as the Green-Thumb-O-Tronic 7.

### OBJECT LESSON Don't Be A Baby

**SCRIPTURE REFERENCE:** Proverbs 29:15

**TAKE HOME POINT:** Do the right thing without being told.

**WHAT YOU NEED:** • 1 Large Baby Ruth candy bar.

• Enough fun-size candy bars for every child.

### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

 Hand out funsize Baby Ruth candy bars at the end of class.

#### **OBJECT LESSON APPLICATION:**

(Hold up the Baby Ruth candy bar.)

Have you ever been at the grocery store and you saw a child ask his mom for a candy bar?

"Mom, can I have a Baby Ruth?"

Mom says "no," the kid starts to scream and throw a fit.

(Jump up and down and start to scream. Don't be afraid to lay aside your dignity for a little bit.)

"I want a Baby Ruth! And I want it now!"

I know that none of you guys have ever do that, but have you ever seen a kid do that? What is everybody thinking? Everyone is thinking, "What a big baby that kid is."

Have you ever seen the mom or dad give in and give the child what they wanted? It is embarrassing for the child and the parent.



### **Don't Be A Baby** Object Lesson — continued

That is what the Bible means when it says, "A child who gets his own way brings his mother to shame."

We have been talking about the Agape kind of love. Do you think the kid in the grocery store is loving his parents when he throws a fit? No way. He is thinking about three things: me, myself and I.

How do we love our parents? We love our parents by obeying them and by honoring them. If mom tells you to pick up your toys, what should you do if you want to love your mom?

Let me ask you a question. How many times does your mom have to ask you to pick up your toys before you do it? You show your parents that you love them when you obey them the first time. Today, I am going to ask you to take a step up in your love for your mom and dad.

Obedience is doing what you are told to do. Honor is doing things before your mom asks you to. In other words you pick up your toys without being told to pick them up. You clean your room without being told. You brush your teeth without being told.

Stop being a baby. Stop depending on your mom to do everything for you. Do things for yourself without being told.

At the end of class I am going to give every kid a Baby Ruth candy bar.

When I give it to you I want you to say this, "I'm going to stop being a baby. I'm going to start doing things without being told."



## INTER-ACTIVE OBJECT LESSON

### Attitude Check

**WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:** 

We need to obey our parents with the right attitude. It's one way that we honor them.

WHAT YOU NEED:

2 plastic tubs filled with warm water (1 for washing, 1 for rinsing)

Dish soap

2 piles of dirty dishes (smear with ketchup or tomato sauce

2 dish cloths

2 towels for drying

Watch with a second hand

**PREPARATION:** 

- Fill the plastic tubs with warm water
- Place 1 pile of dirty dishes and the 2 plastic tubs on a table in front of the class.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

- You are going to have a "Dishwashing Race" between the boys and girls.
- 2 contestants (one boy and one girl).
- When picking your 2 contestants, draw it out and let it take awhile. You want them to beg to be in the race.
- Select a 5th Grade boy and a 5th Grade girl.
- Let the girl go first.

### **GAME RULES:**

- Each contestant gets 5 dirty dishes they are to wash, rinse them and dry them off.
- Time each one separately.
- Give a prize to the one who is the fastest.

#### **SPIRITUAL APPLICATION:**

Did you guys see how many kids "wanted to" wash the dishes when we made a race out of it? Does your mom ever ask you to wash the dishes? Do you ever gripe about it? I know I used to say things like, "I washed them yesterday. It is Fred's turn to wash the dishes today." Have you ever washed the dishes with a bad attitude? It is good that you obeyed your parents the Bible tells us to honor our parents. That means that we obey them with a good attitude. Our attitude has to do with our "want to". Your attitude is a choice just like your obedience is a choice. Next time mom asks for help with the dishes, surprise her and obey her with a good attitude.
