FINDING GOD

**WHAT IS GOD
LOOKING FOR?**

MEMORY VERSE:

Luke 19:10, "For the Son of man is come to seek and save that which was lost.."(KJV)

TAKE HOME POINT:

God has a heart for lost people.

2. BIBLE TIME

READ:

Matthew 4:17-19

MAIN POINT:

God has everything anyone could ever want – except for one thing, lost people! Jesus said, “The Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.” The heart that God has for a relationship with His children is what compelled Him to create the universe. It is also why Jesus came to earth.

DISCUSS:

- Everybody has something that makes them tick.
- For some people it is sports or video games.
- For other people it is making money.
- Many people are into collecting things such as baseball cards, comic books or antiques.
- What is it that makes God tick? What does God the Father live for? YOU.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Who did Jesus come to save? (that which is lost)
2. Who did Jesus pick to train? (the disciples were not trained theologians)
3. Who did Jesus preach to? (the lost)

3. FAMILY TIME

A GIFT FOR GOD

MAIN POINT:

- *God has a heart for lost people.*

WHAT YOU DO:

- Write Luke 19:10 on a piece of paper.
- Put the piece of paper inside a small gift box and wrap the gift box.

DISCUSS:

- When you think of Father God what do you think of?
- Allow response from family members.
- He is the creator of the universe and He has everything - well almost everything.
- Show the box and let

one person open the box that has a clue to what God looks for.

- Father God wants a relationship with people.
- The Father God has a heart for lost people.
- He is looking for people because He wants to draw close to us.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. What is the one thing that Father God is looking for? (lost people)
2. Why is He looking for lost people? (He wants a relationship with people)
