**MEMORY VERSE:**

yourselves. Do what it says." (NIV)

**MEMORY VERSE:** 

You know the right thing to do, so just do it.

Proverbs 13:20 says, "He who walks with wise men will be wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm." (NASB)

A wise person is someone who knows the right thing to do and does it. A fool is somebody who knows the right thing to do and chooses not to do it. The Bible promises that fools, and people who hang out with fools, will suffer harm.

We have already established that our children have a conscience that tells them right from wrong, but the bottom line is do they do the right thing?

You could have the whole Bible memorized, but the Bible only helps you if you do what it says. Many times when you quote a Bible verse people will say, "I already know that verse. I've heard it a hundred times." Yes, but are you doing that Bible verse? The only part of the Bible that is really yours is that part that you do.

Isaiah I: I 9 says, "If you be willing and obedient, you will eat the good of the land." In other words, not only does God want you to obey, He wants you to have a good attitude while you obey.

### **OBJECT LESSON**

### Are You Blossoming?

**TAKE HOME POINT:** 

We blossom when we obey God.

**WHAT YOU NEED:** 

A flowering plant, a dead plant

#### **OBJECT LESSON APPLICATION:**

"Every branch in me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.... anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them and cast them into the fire and they are burned."

John 15:2,6 (NASB)

This plant represents a Christian who bears fruit. The flowers are the fruit of the plant. When we see a plant that has flowers on it, what does that tell us?

(Allow for response.)

It tells us two things:

- I. The plant is alive.
- 2. The plant is connected to the vine .

How does a Christian bear fruit? We bear fruit whenever we obey God. When we know the right thing to do and we do it, we are bearing fruit. We are blossoming like this plant. The

### **Are You Blossoming?** Object Lesson — continued

Bible also says that you are a wise person when you know the right thing to do and you do it. Who can tell me some specific things you can do to bear fruit or blossom? (Allow for response.)

- Obey my parents
- Read the Bible
- Pay my tithes
- Go to church
- Be kind to my friends
- Be kind to my brothers and sisters
- Lift my hands to worship God
- Tell others about Jesus

Every time you do one of these things you are blossoming or bearing fruit. Every time you know the right thing to do and you do it you are being wise. Even if you have done a bunch of stupid things, you can still make the right choice next time.

This plant (hold up the dead plant) represents what the Bible calls a fool. This is someone who knows the right thing to do (he knows what the Bible says) but he chooses not to do it. What happens to this plant? The Bible says that the Christian that doesn't bear any fruit is cut off and thrown into the fire.

So be a wise man, and do what what the Bible says.



## SHORT FILM APPLICATION:

### "The C-Team"

What did God ask Joey to do? God asked Joey to join the ministry team. Did Joey listen to what God asked him to do? He did, didn't he?

What else did God ask Joey to do? Well, God asked Joey to share his Pixie Sticks with the A-Team kids.

Joey didn't listen at first did he? What happened when Joey disobeyed? It was kind of like the story of Jonah. Joey was trapped in the elevator on the 11th floor of the elevator for three days and nights.

## INTER-ACTIVE OBJECT LESSON

### Wheel Barrel Relay

**WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:** Learn to pull your own weight and not depend on others to

make decisions for you.

**WHAT YOU NEED:** 4 Contestants

Masking tape

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Use the masking tape to mark your relay race track.

- 2 contestants per team.
- When the race begins, 1st team member gets on hands and knees, the 2nd team member holds the feet of 1st team member, and they race using the hands on the ground of the 1st team member.
- Both team members race.
- The team that finishes first wins.

#### **SPIRITUAL APPLICATION:**

Wasn't that fun? What is a wheel barrel used for? A wheel barrel is used to haul dirt and heavy things around outside. As you grow older it is important that you push your own weight. You need to learn to take responsibility for yourself. It is important that you learn how to make right decisions and that you learn to not depend on others to make choices for you. You need to learn to carry your own weight. Ask yourself three questions: Do I go to church because I want to or because I have to? Do I read my Bible because I want to or because I have to? Do I pray because I want to or because I have to? If you do these things because you have to, you are not at the place where God wants you to be. The Bible says, "the willing and the obedient will eat the good of the land." A wise person is someone who pushes his own wheel barrel. A wise person is someone who has his own faith in God and doesn't depend on his parent's faith. A wise person is someone who knows the right thing to do and he does it because he wants to. He knows what it will do for him.
