MEMORY VERSE:

I Corinthians 6:19, "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you...." (NIV)

BOTTOM LINE: The Holy Spirit is in me.

TO THE TEACHER:

This lesson answers three questions:

- 1. Who is the Holy Spirit?
- 2. Where is the Holy Spirit?
- 3. What does the Holy Spirit do?

Who is the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God. When Jesus went back to heaven, He sent the Holy Spirit to help us. Jesus does not walk the earth today like He did in the Bible, but He sent the Holy Spirit to be with us and live inside of us.

The Holy Spirit lives inside of me. When we get born again the Holy Spirit comes to live inside. There is another experience with the Holy Spirit that the Bible calls "being filled with the spirit." The Holy Spirit lives inside you to help you. After you get saved you can also get filled with the Spirit. When you get filled with the Spirit, the Holy Spirit comes upon you to minister to other people.

What does the Holy Spirit do?

- The Holy Spirit is your helper.
- The Holy Spirit is your comforter when bad things happen.
- The Holy Spirit is your best friend.
- The Holy Spirit is your guide. He is always there and He always knows the right thing to do.



 If you listen to the Holy Spirit you will make the right choice every time.

The Holy Spirit even knows the future. He will protect you from bad stuff that is about to happen.

Learn to listen to the Holy Spirit and you will always be a success.

CHARACTERS: Not Too Bright

PROPS: Banana peel

DRAMA SCRIPT:

Teacher: Boys and girls, today we have a special guest. Not Too Bright is

Teacher: Well Mr. Not Too Bright, the Holy Spirit is real and He lives on the inside

of all of these smart kids and me.

Not Too Bright: If He's real how come I've never seen Him before?

Teacher: Because He lives on the inside. He isn't just walking around going out

for burgers and fries. He's in your heart.

Not Too Bright: NOOOO! Not in my heart!

Teacher: Well, why not?

Not Too Bright: Cause I'm Not Too Bright!

Teacher: Hey what's that in your hand?

Not Too Bright: Oh this? When you said it was a free gift I thought I should get you

something.

Not Too Bright: TA DA!

Teacher: Why would you get me a banana peel?

want to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

Not Too Bright: Bye Kids. Don't forget to eat your tin cans and banana peels so you

grow big and strong!

Teacher: Oh man, that guy is mixed up. He didn't think the Holy Spirit was real,

but of course we know the truth that He lives inside each one of us.

OBJECT LESSON

A Measure of the Holy Spirit

TAKE HOME POINT:

Salvation and the baptism in the Holy Spirit are two separate experiences.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Two clear plastic cups, a permanent magic marker, and a pitcher of water.

PREPARATION:

Punch holes in one cup with a nail, and write the word SIN on it. Write JESUS on the other cup.

OBJECT LESSON APPLICATION:

I have two cups here. Let's pretend that each cup represents a person who has not been filled with the Holy Spirit. This person (hold up the SIN cup) doesn't have Jesus in his heart. His heart is full of sin. Even if the Holy Spirit came upon this person, his spirit could not receive it, because it is full of sin.

(Pour water into the SIN cup; water should leak out through the holes in the bottom of the cup.)

(Now hold up the JESUS cup.)

This person has Jesus in their heart, so they are ready to be filled with the Holy Spirit. This person is born again. He already has a "measure" of the Holy Spirit when he became born again.

(Pour one inch of water into the JESUS cup, but do not fill it up.)

A Measure of the Holy Spirit Object Lesson — continued

The Holy Spirit can do a lot of different things for you. He comes inside of you when you are born again.

What does He do inside of me? The Holy Spirit is my guide. He will talk to me about my future and tell me which way to go in life. The Holy Spirit is my helper. He comes inside of me to help me.

The Holy Spirit also wants to help other people, so He will help me to help others. How does He do that? I am glad that you asked.

There is a second experience of the Holy Spirit called "being filled with the Holy Spirit."

When I get saved I receive a measure of the Holy Spirit. (Hold up the JESUS cup with the small amount of water in it.)

There is more with the Holy Spirit. I can also be filled with the Holy Spirit. (Pour water into the JESUS glass until it overflows.)

When I get "filled with the Spirit" the Holy Spirit comes on me to help other people.



INTER-ACTIVE OBJECT LESSON

The Holy Spirit - My Guide

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:

The Holy Spirit is inside us to lead us and guide us. He is our

helper and best friend.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Two large flashlights or battery powered lanterns (the bigger the better), one new set of batteries and one dead set of batteries (always test everything ahead of time).

INSTRUCTIONS:

Set the large flashlight and both sets of batteries on a table in front of class.

SPIRITUAL APPLICATION:

(Hold up the new batteries.) These batteries are like the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is our power source, just like these batteries are the power source to this flashlight. Without the batteries the flashlight has no power. (Try to turn on the flashlight.) The Holy Spirit lives inside of us, just like the batteries go inside of this flashlight. (Pick a volunteer from the class to put the new batteries inside of the flashlight and turn it on. Assist them if you need to. Turn the lights off and ask your volunteer to walk around the classroom using the flashlight as a guide. Tell them to always walk in the light.)

TO THE KIDS:

What does the Holy Spirit do for us? The Holy Spirit is our guide. He will lead us into all truth. He is our helper. He will help us make wise decisions, but we have to walk in the light of the Holy Spirit.

(Pick a second volunteer and ask him to put the dead batteries in the second flashlight.) These batteries are dead. They don't work. People who are not born again do not have the Holy Spirit. The Bible says they are spiritually dead. (Turn off the lights and ask the volunteer to walk around the room with his flashlight. He may not be able to and that helps you make your point.) The world is full of darkness and it is difficult to live our lives without the Holy Spirit.
