# 2. BIBLETIME

# **READ:**

I Corinthians 12:18

### **MAIN POINT:**

In the book of Corinthians
Paul describes the 9
gifts of the Spirit. These
gifts are for the body of
Christ to bless, encourage
and reveal. The Word
of Knowledge reveals
something that has
happened in the past or
the present.

## **DISCUSS:**

- Sometimes people get confused and think that all knowledge is the kind of knowledge you learn in school.
- But, we're talking about "supernatural" knowledge, something only the Holy Spirit can show you.
- The Holy Spirit can reveal something supernatural to you or you may just "know" something about someone.
- We need to remember, this is a very special gift from the Holy Spirit and the purpose is to encourage others, to reveal God to them, or to help you know how to pray for them.

# 3. FAMILYTIME

### **FACT-FINDING GAME**

#### **MAIN POINT:**

The word of knowledge is supernatural knowledge about the present or the past.

# WHAT YOU DO:

- Have the entire family sit together for some "factfinding"!
- Choose a topic that
   is age appropriate for
   your family. For younger
   children, look up facts
   on animals and for older
   possibly facts on history,
   sports, or something they
   like.
- Use a family trivia game, an encyclopedia or computer to find facts. Another option is to use the "Cool Facts App" on an ipod.

 Spend about 15 minutes playing the game or looking up facts.

## **AFTER THE GAME:**

- There are a lot of ways to find information and facts.
- You can play games, look in books or use the computer.
- There is one kind of information you cannot find by looking it up; it is supernatural knowledge from the Holy Spirit.
- The way the Holy Spirit shares this supernatural information is through the word of knowledge.
- Some things you can't just look up, not even in the Bible.

#### SPIRITUAL EXERCISE:

- Take time to pray in the Holy Spirit and then "be quiet."
- Allow the Holy Spirit to speak to your heart.
- Have everyone share what they hear in their heart.
- This is how you can train yourself to HEAR the Holy Spirit.
