## 2. BIBLE TIME

### READ:

- Genesis 1:1-5

### MAIN POINT:

*Genesis, chapter 1, talks about creation. How everything came to be. People who don't believe in God think the world was just a big accident. Christians believe that God created the world and everything in it. The world didn't just happen, it was designed by God. When you come to God you must believe that "God is." In other words you must believe that God is real, that He exists.*

### QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Who created God? (He always was)
2. Does everyone believe these verses? (no)

### DISCUSS:

- Talk about how foolish it is to believe the world was an accident.
- Talk about some things that are too detailed to be an accident.

## 3. FAMILY TIME

### MAIN POINT:

*When we see nature, we can see God.*

### WHAT YOU DO:

- Take a walk on a hiking trail.
- The main thing that you want to do is point out all the cool things that God created - in nature.
- Make a list of those things as you see them:
- Romans 1:20, "For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God."

### QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. From our list of all the things we saw today - what was your favorite?
2. Why was it your favorite?

### DISCUSS:

- In Romans 1:20, it tells us that through everything that God made, we can see His invisible qualities.
- What are His invisible qualities?
- What does that mean that "they have no excuse for not knowing God?"
