

3. SMALL GROUP Lesson

JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD

PROPS: Jelly beans for each group (or Easter-type candy)

LESSON:

- (Hold the jelly beans up.)
- When I see jelly beans, it reminds me of Faster.
- Faster is when we celebrate the resurrection of lesus.
- Of all the people that have lived, no one else has ever died and risen from the dead, except lesus.
- Lazarus was raised from the dead, but he died again.

POINT TO MAKE:

- lesus was raised from the dead and He did not die again.
- We celebrate Martin Luther King's birthday and George Washington's birthday, but lesus is the only person that we celebrate His birthday and His resurrection day.

DISCUSS:

- One of our core beliefs is that lesus rose from the dead.
- There are 3 arguments against His resurrection:
 - 1. The "Fainting Argument''
 - 2. The "Body Snatchers Argument"
 - 3. The "Thief Factor"

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

- I. Why is Easter a special day? (celebration of Jesus raising from the dead)
- 2. Has anyone, other than lesus, died and lived again? (no)
- 3. When Jesus' disciples went to His tomb what did they find? (it was empty)
- 4. Where was lesus? (He had risen from the dead)

THE CORE JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD

MEMORY VERSE:

Luke 24:6. "He isn't here! He has risen from the dead." (NIV)

BOTTOM LINE:

lesus Rose From The Dead



1. PRE-SERVICE Activity

- During the Pre-Service Activity, group leaders will direct conversation and games to help kids make friends at church.
- As a group leader you have the choice of Ice Breaker Questions or Game to use as the children arrive.

ICE BREAKER Questions:

OUESTION #746:

- Who is your best friend?
- Why?

QUESTION #216:

- What famous person would you like to meet?
- Why?

ICE BREAKER *Game:*

FINISH THE STORY

- Have children get in a circle.
- Pick one child to start.
- They begin "The Story." Example: Once upon a time....
- The next person adds to the story.
 Example: Once upon a time, a puppy was born...
- It continues around the room.
- You can go around as many times as you would like.



2. BIBLE Time

READ THE BIBLE: Matthew 27:62-28:10

- Ist-2nd Grade: Use picture Bible.
- 3rd Grade and up: Have each child read one verse out loud. Go around the room.

This works best if everyone uses the same, easy-to-read translation of the Bible. We recommend the NIV Bible for 3rd to 5th Grade and a picture Bible for 1st to 2nd Grade.

BIBLE STORY:

Jesus Lives!

BIBLE CONNECTION:

Jesus died on a cross. His disciples saw His body. Three days later He was not in the tomb. Jesus was alive and lives forever.

BIBLE QUESTIONS:

- I. Why did Pilate command the tomb to be sealed? (people thought Jesus' disciples would steal his body)
- 2. Why were Martha and Mary afraid? (they thought Jesus was a ghost)
- 3. What happened to Jesus' body? (He rose from the dead)

Point To Make: Another thing that makes Jesus different from others is that He died, and rose again from the dead. He lives now.
